- Have a minimum of three years of professional experience and are 35 years of age or younger;
- Possess a passion for international education, global service and/or with a direct connection to the countries we work in;

- Eager to advocate for School the World's mission and learn about our nonprofit operations and internal needs.

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES OF OUR MEMBERS:

- Fundraising: We ask that all members commit to raising support for School the World's
 mission and current programming needs. There is a large net of fundraising options such as
 hosting quarterly events (happy hours/Beers for Books, 5K run, etc.), corporate &
 foundational giving, grants, peer-to-peer fundraisers, our annual Gala, and more.
- Networking: School the World believes our advisory board members are highly motivated, passionate and strong relationship builders. Members can open doors within their corporate offices, alma maters and own social groups that lead to new donor partnerships and increase our overall network of supporters.
- Engagement and Advocacy: YPAB members can become involved with School the World's programming in a variety of ways, including participating in speaking opportunities, promoting events and opportunities, and being an advocate for education.
- Pro-Bono Work or Service Travel: This can be in the capacity of volunteering personal time & skills (i.e. tech, marketing, etc.) as well as participating in our international global service program. Members have the ability to form a group of young professionals or corporate colleagues for a service trip. An excellent team-building and networking opportunity!

COMMITMENT OF MEMBERSHIP:

- Term commitment of two years, long-term opportunities available.
- Members are required to attend 3 out of 4 quarterly meetings throughout the calendar year, unless previously discussed. Meetings will be a combination of in-person and virtual. A final annual meeting will be in conjunction with our Board of Directors and Advisory Board.
